Part II - Divine Providence

Experience The Divine in Your Life

1) What is Divine Providence?

Divine providence (Hebrew: פרטית השגחה - Hashgochoh Protis or Hashgaha Peratit) is discussed throughout Rabbinic literature, by the classical Jewish philosophers, and by the tradition of Jewish mysticism, especially the Baal Shem Tov, the founder of the Chassidic movement. He taught that every event in the universe and every experience in a person's life, and their every aspect, is specifically guided and determined by the Divine will.

4) Italian Kabbalist Joseph Ergas (1685-1730)

The Italian Kabbalist Joseph Ergas (1685-1730), in his *Shomer Emunim (Preserving Beliefs)*, summarizes what he considers to be the Kabbalistic views on the subject: "Nothing occurs by accident, without intention and divine providence, as it is written in Leviticus 26:24

'Then will I also walk with you in hostility (chance) [be-keri].'
